

Admission Requirements

Quebec CEGEP Students

Normally the student enters the first year of their three year program (90 credits +) after completion of the two year CEGEP program in either Health Science or Pure and Applied Science.

Note: Students must have completed their CEGEP DEC before acceptance into the program.

Mature Student Entry

Students who are over 21 years of age and have not engaged in full-time study for the last 24 months are eligible to enter the University under the Mature Student Entry Profile. Students who might benefit from these alternative provisions should consult the "Mature Student Programs" entry in the University Calendar. Out of Province Students

Special entry provisions also exist for students arriving from outside the province of Quebec. Normally these students must complete the fundamental science courses (see Table 1) in addition to the program requirement of 90 credits. With this added academic requirement, students will likely complete the entire academic requirements in 4 years.

Transfer Students

Change of Concentration

Students currently registered in a BSc program wishing to transfer into the Department of Exercise Science must have completed at least 24 credits at Concordia University with a minimum GPA of 3.0. Students may submit their letter of intent and up-to-date University transcript directly to the Department of Exercise Science.

Department deadlines for applying for a Change of Concentration are August 15th (September entry) and December 15th (January entry).

Degree Transfer

Students requesting a change of degree status are required to submit an *Application for Degree Transfer*. This form and instructions can be found at <http://registrar.concordia.ca/>.

NOTE: All students must be sure to follow the academic program requirements that are clearly stated in their letter of admission.

Students who have satisfied the academic admission requirements for entry into the Department will be officially accepted into either the BSc Major or one of the BSc Specialization programs in Exercise Science. However, students must maintain a GPA of 3.0 in Exercise Science courses in order to remain in the Athletic Therapy or Clinical Exercise Physiology Specialization Options.
